WORKSHOP II (Creating Math problems) - each partner school presented different problems using mixed operations, combination, geometric measurement, etc.

The students created new problems using the patterns previously presented and found the right solutions and recorded them in digital format;

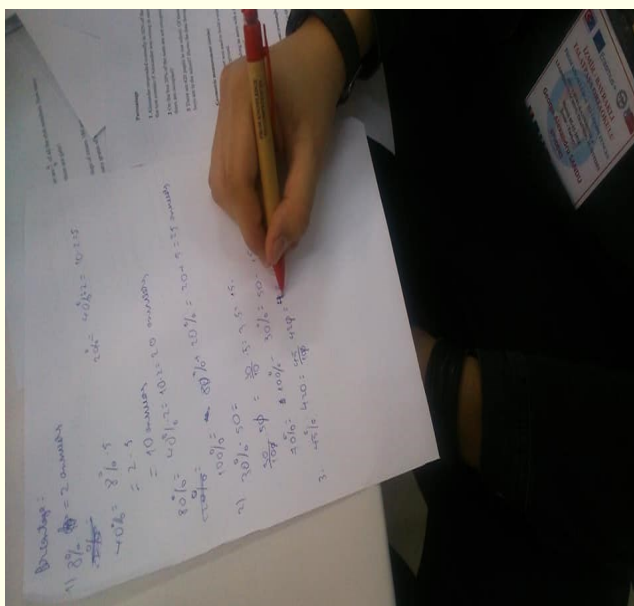
